Short Cuts - If you are using a PC, Cmmd = Ctrl and Opt = Alt.

Cmmd+A= Press the Command and A keys together

MAC's

Cmmd+A= (Select All)

Cmmd+C= (Copy)

Cmmd+D= (Deselect current selection)

Cmmd+Shift+D= (Reselect Deselected selection)

Cmmd+T= (Transform)

Cmmd+V= (Paste)

Cmmd+X= (cut)

Cmmd+Z= (go back one action)

Cmmd+Shift+Z= (go back multiple actions)

Cmmd+S= (Save)

Cmmd+P= (Print)

Cmmd+Shift+3= (Print screen)

Cmmd+Shift+4= (Print screen) selection)

Cmmd+Shift+I= (Inverse current selection)

Opt+Back Space= (Fill)

Cmmd+O= (Fit your image to Screen)

H= (Hand Tool) - The hand tool allows for quick panning.

Z= (Zoom Tool)

B= (Brush Tool)

Opt+Delete = fill layer with foreground color or **Shift+Delete** to fill with background color;

Press and Hold SHIFT, while drawing to draw precise, symmetrical circle or square or straight line

Cmmd++ = Zoom in

Cmmd+- = Zoom out

Cmmd+Shift+N =(create new layer)

Cmmd+J=(duplicate active layer)

Cmmd+E= (merge selected layers)

Cmmd+Shift+E= (merge all layers)
