Adding Colour -

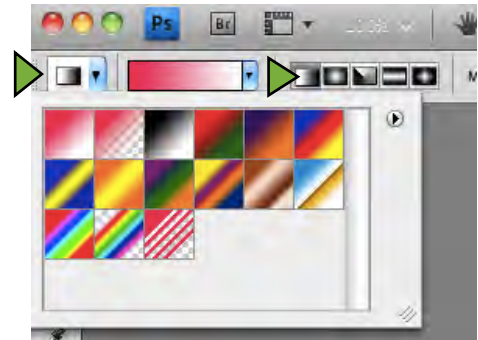


Hue Saturation
You can adjust the colour of any layer or file by going into - Image - Adjustments -
You can make an image colour brighter, adjust the balance or contrast. You can even go into Hue Saturation and totally change your images colour scheme. Drag the little triangles to the hue you want

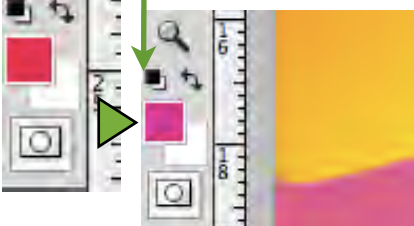
Colour Swatches
Use colour swatches to choose colour schemes and to colour areas



Gradient Tool
Use to colour areas
You can choose a variety of gradient styles and colours



Colour Picker Tool
Allows you to choose any colour for your design.
Click on the box and choose colour from the complete range.
If you want to change the colour to the background colour, click on the black and white



Colour Picker Tool
Use the colour spectrum on the side to choose the colour hue. Then use the circle to choose the exact shade you want. You can add this colour to your swatches
